Introduction

Registration and Membership

The membership for the Civil Services Club is open to all the students of the College but the number shall not exceed 60 every year. The Club plans to enroll 60 students annually by conducting a screening test of one hour duration. The question paper for the preliminary evaluation will be provided by the NACS and it attempts to assess the general knowledge, aptitude, awareness of current affairs and so on.

Fee Structure

The Students who are enrolled to the Club shall have to pay an amount of Rs, 100/- as Registration Fee and Rs. 1000/- as Annual Fee. The Registration Fee is a one-time payment while the annual fee should be remitted every year during the month of June.

Class and Timing

The Club plans organize different sessions on various topics related to Civil Service Examination on a regular basis without disturbing the normal schedule of the College. Experts from the NACS Academy, experienced faculty from other institutions, eminent personalities, experienced academicians, civil servants etc shall engage classes on Saturdays. The Club also has a plan to organize institutional visits and rendezvous with popular persons as part of motivational sessions.
