Action Taken Report of the meeting held on June 4, 2025

The following actions were taken in response to the decisions made during the IQAC meeting held on June 3, 2024:

Departmental Action Plans and Academic Calendar Preparation

As per the instructions given in the meeting, all departments prepared and submitted their respective Action Plans within the stipulated timeframe.

FYUGP Implementation in the Academic Year 2024-2025

In line with the decision taken in the IQAC meeting, the College-Level Academic Committee (CLAC) was formed to oversee the smooth implementation of the Four-Year Undergraduate Programme (FYUGP). Dr. Ranjith Krishnan K.R., from the Department of English, was appointed as the Coordinator of CLAC, and the committee was constituted as per the guidelines set by the University of Kerala. Additionally, directions were issued to all Heads of Departments (HoDs) to form Department-Level Academic Committees (DLACs) to facilitate the effective execution of FYUGP at the departmental level. FYUGP was officially inaugurated in the college on July 1, 2024, and classes commenced as per schedule, marking the successful beginning of the new academic structure.

Data Collection for AQAR 2023-24

The IQAC provided clear guidelines to all departments regarding the collection and submission of AQAR data. Necessary instructions were communicated, and departments have initiated the process to compile the required information for timely submission.

World Environment Day Celebration

In line with the meeting's decision, World Environment Day was successfully observed on June 5, 2024. Apart from the NCC and NSS units taking the lead, many academic departments also conducted plantation drives, awareness sessions, and eco-friendly initiatives, ensuring active student participation.

IIQA Submission for NAAC Reaccreditation in RAF Format

The institution successfully submitted the IIQA on June 25, 2024, within the prescribed deadline. The submission was reviewed and accepted by NAAC, marking a significant step forward in the reaccreditation process. Preparations for the next stages of the assessment are now underway.

International Yoga Day Celebration

As per the directive, International Yoga Day was observed on June 21, 2024. The Department of Physical Education, in collaboration with NSS and NCC, organized a yoga demonstration and awareness session, encouraging student and faculty participation.

NEP Orientation and Sensitization Programme for Faculty

Faculty members were instructed to enrol in the NEP Orientation and Sensitization Programme conducted by the UGC Teacher Education Centres. While some faculty members have successfully completed the programme, efforts are being made to ensure that the remaining members complete the training within the stipulated time.
