

**ACTION PLAN 2022-2023** 

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- Align institutional programs and practices with the goals of the National Education Policy (NEP). Develop programs and initiatives that incorporate NEP principles, such as multidisciplinary learning and experiential education.
- Conduct workshops and training sessions to familiarize faculty with NEP requirements.
- Register the institution with the Institution's Innovation Council (IIC) to foster innovation, entrepreneurship, and creativity among students and faculty.
- Establish a core committee for IIC registration comprising faculty members, student representatives, and an external innovation expert.
- Establish an Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) Cell that fosters awareness, protection, and commercialization of intellectual property among students, faculty, and researchers in the institution.
- Organize an orientation program to introduce the concept of intellectual property rights and the role of the IPR Cell to the faculty, researchers, and students.
- Organize regular IPR awareness programs, including workshops and seminars conducted by legal experts and industry professionals.
- Facilitate employment opportunities for students through regular placement drives. Collaborate with companies for the on-campus recruitment drive. Provide pre-placement training and career counselling for students.
- Task the college's Research Forum with inspiring students to pursue research by organizing regular seminars, workshops, and discussions with accomplished researchers.
- Motivate students to engage in research projects, publish academic papers, and participate in field visits, fostering a culture of inquiry and academic excellence.
- Encourage Students to Pursue Research through the College's Research Forum

- Strengthen the knowledge base of students by incorporating exposure to real-life situations such as internships, industrial visits, and community-based projects.
- Encourage students to participate in nature-friendly and sustainable activities.
- Leverage advanced practices such as virtual and online teaching methods to enhance the learning experience and ensure that education is accessible and adaptable to the evolving digital environment.
- Regularly hold workshops, awareness sessions, and training on gender sensitivity and equality, and integrate gender-related topics into the curriculum to promote inclusivity.
- Organize seminars and workshops on entrepreneurship, inviting successful entrepreneurs to share insights. Provide support for student-led startups through mentorship and incubation facilities
- Ensure the campus is accessible and accommodating to students and staff with disabilities.
- Develop partnerships with other colleges to organize joint seminars, research projects, and student exchange programs, promoting shared learning and resource exchange.
- Encourage a balance between academic excellence and extracurricular engagement. Introduce more clubs and activity-based programs that offer leadership, teamwork, and personal growth opportunities.
- Increase the frequency and effectiveness of library use among students and faculty. Launch campaigns promoting library services and introduce digital learning resources.
