## Policy Documents for Guidelines and Eligibility for Various Government, Non-Governmental Scholarships and Freeships

## **Guidelines for National Scholarships**

1. **Inspire Scholarship**: "Innovation in Science Pursuit for Inspired Research (INSPIRE)" is an innovative programme sponsored and managed by the Department of Science & Technology for attraction of talent to science. The basic objective of INSPIRE is to communicate to the youth of the country the excitements of creative pursuit of science, attract talent to the study of science at an early age and thus build the required critical human resource pool for strengthening and expanding the Science & Technology system and R & D base. A striking feature of the programme is that it does not believe in conducting competitive exams for identification of talent at any level. It believes in and relies on the efficacy of the existing educational structure for identification of talent. This scholarship is for science stream students which begins from undergraduate programme and can continue the scholarship to postgraduate and research programme with an yearly allowance of 60,000/- to 1,20,000/-.

2. **Post-Matric Scholarship for SC students**: The objective of the scheme is to appreciably increase the Gross Enrolment Ratio of SC students in higher education with a focus on those from the poorest households, by providing financial assistance at post-matriculation or post-secondary stage to enable them to complete their education. Scope. These scholarships are available for studies in India only and the awardees are selected by the State Government/Union Territory to which the applicant actually belongs (i.e. the State/UT in which permanently settled or domiciled, as per the terms of domicile decided by the State). This is applicable to all the students who are currently beneficiaries of the scheme as well as fresh admissions.

3. **Junior Research Fellowship (JRF)**: The objective of the JRF scheme is to provide opportunities to NET-JRF qualified candidates to undertake advanced studies and research leading to M.Phil./Ph.D. Degrees in Humanities and science. Target Group: Candidates who have qualified in NET-JRF or the UGC-CSIR joint tests. Eligibility: Candidates who have qualified in NET-JRF or the UGC-CSIR joint test. However, the registration for the M.Phil./Ph.D. is made by the

Universities/Institutions/Colleges within stipulated period of two years from the date of declaration of result or date of issue of award letter/date of joining the fellowship.

- 4. **Post-Matric Scholarship for Students with Disabilities**: The scheme is conducted by the Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disability (DEPD) under Government of India in order to financially support disabled students studying in class 11 to post-graduate degree or Diploma courses recognized by AICTE or UGC. Students with at least 40 percent disability with a maximum family annual income of INR 2.50 lakh (Two lakh fifty thousand) can apply for the scholarship scheme through the National Scholarship Portal. Beneficiaries will be granted with allowances for maintenance, book, and disability.

- 5. Central Sector Scheme of Scholarship for College and University Students (PM-USP CSSS): To provide financial assistance to meritorious students from poor families to meet a part of their day-to-day expenses while pursuing higher studies. The scholarships are awarded by Ministry of Education, Government of India on the basis of results of Higher Secondary / Class XII Board Examination. A maximum of 82,000 fresh scholarships per annum are provided for pursuing graduate / postgraduate degree in colleges and universities. - 6. **PG Indira Gandhi Scholarship for Single Girl Child**: A scholarship scheme by the University Grants Commission for Girl students who are admitted in the first year of PG courses in any designated university or a postgraduate college, and happen to be the only girl child in the family. The scheme has been introduced with an aim to compensate direct costs of girl education at all levels, especially for such girls who happen to be the only girl child in their families. This will help the girl child of our country to move ahead with the objective of getting education. It is very important in India to support the girl child because of how backward they are due to poverty and also because of the discrimination that they face from their parents or society.

1. **Aspire Scholarship**: It is the most prestigious scholarship program initiated by the Government of Kerala and various teaching departments present in the Kerala state. This scholarship is provided to the students who are currently pursuing post-graduation or Ph.D. degrees from affiliated colleges of the University of Kerala. The selected candidates will be getting 8000 per month and 10000 per month, especially for the people doing internships outside Kerala state.

2. Suvarna Jubilee Merit Scholarship: It is offered by the Government of Kerala to the first-year UG and PG students of Kerala. The scholarship aims at supporting meritorious students from the financially weaker section of society to pursue higher education. Those selected for the scholarship will receive a reward of ₹ 10,000 per annum.

3. **Prathibha Scholarship Programme**: Scholarships are awarded to students of Kerala origin who have qualified meritoriously in the Higher Secondary Examination, for pursuing Undergraduate and Postgraduate degree courses in Basic/Natural Science in Institutions/ Universities in India. The objective of the program is to motivate aspiring students to higher studies and a career in Science. Annual scholarship @ Rs. 12,000/-, Rs. 18,000/-, Rs. 24,000/- respectively for 1st, 2nd and 3rd years at U.G. level and @ Rs. 40,000/- & Rs. 60,000/- respectively for 1st and 2nd years at P.G.

4. Vidhya Samunnathi Scholarship: Started in the financial year 2013-14, under this scheme scholarships will be given to students studying from high school level to post graduation. Special scholarships will be given to students studying professional courses like CA/ICWA/CS and those studying in IIT, IIM, NIT and similar National Institutes. Applicants should be from non-reservation forward community and a resident of Kerala. Annual income of the family should be less than 2 lakhs based on all sources. Only online applications are accepted. You may logon to www.kswcfc.org for the same. Applicants must have a Bank account in any recognized bank.

5. **Snehapoorvam Scholarship**: The scholarship will be highly beneficial to the students who are currently staying in Kerala state but are not able to support their education due to the lack of financial funds and a supportive family. This scholarship will help people to get prestigious educational opportunities if they are below 18

years of age. Around 75000 children are currently living in orphanages around Kerala state. All of these children will be able to get the benefit of this scheme. 1000 Rupees will be provided per month to the students and other benefits will be provided as per their study level.

6. **Hindi Scholarship**: Students pursuing their undergraduate studies can apply this scholarship. Any student who has taken Hindi as a mandatory course can apply for this scholarship.

7. **District Merit Scholarship**: Students who have scored A Plus in all subjects in the plus two Examination conducted by Board of Public Examinations, Kerala and who study courses related to Science/ Social science/ Commerce graduate/ ITI/ Poly Technic Course can apply for this scholarship.

- 8. **State Merit Scholarship**: Any first-year student of Under Graduate or Post Graduate course in Govt/ Aided colleges or University Departments who have scored 50% or above in the qualifying Examination and with the family annual income not exceeding 1 Lakh is eligible for applying for this scholarship. - 9. **Joseph Mundassery Scholarship**: This scholarship is offered by the Department of Minority Welfare scholarships as an incentive for the underprivileged students to gain access to higher education.

10. **C.H Muhammed Koya Scholarship**: This scholarship aims to provide educational opportunities among the girl applicants belonging to the minority communities who have enrolled themselves in the 1st year of graduation. 11. E-Grantz for SC/ST/OBC/KPCR/OEC/SEBC Students: The system is an integrated online software solution for the disbursement of the various educational assistance schemes of the Scheduled Castes Development Department. The beneficiaries of any educational assistance scheme have to register by giving their basic details such as Name, Address, Date of Birth, Gender, Mobile Number, Bank

Account details and Aadhar Number. Such registered students can apply through the same application for various schemes. Through a single registration, the system could uniquely identify a student and the details shall be used for the disbursement of educational assistance throughout the period of education under various schemes. Provision for institutions will also be available for entering the applications, in case the student is not able to apply online. The financial assistance reaches the students bank account through Direct Beneficiary Transfer (DBT).

**K.P.C.R Concession**: The Government has awarded educational concession to the students belonging to socially and educationally backward classes in the forward community under Kumara Pillai Commission Report. At the time of admission if the student produces the income certificate in the prescribed form from the village officer within the income limit as given below, he/she will be exempted from paying tuition and special fee.

- 1. Vidyanidhi: Initiated by the teachers and students, the scholarship attempts to empower the meritorious students who come to the institution from less fortunate backgrounds.
